Staines Preparatory School is a non-academically selective School and is committed to enabling each individual pupil to be the best they can be and attain the highest grades possible. It is our aim to raise attainment beyond that predicted in relation to the individual pupil's ability.

Staines Preparatory School uses a variety of internal and external assessments to inform teaching and learning. These assessments are intended to facilitate pupil progress and the evaluation of that progress against relevant national norms.
